Is there a way to browse the internet without leaving a trace?

Answer:

Yes, with Internet Explorer 8 (IE8). With a feature called InPrivate Browsing. Activate it by selecting InPrivate Browsing from the Safety menu. A new IE8 window will open with a blue InPrivate indicator to the left of the address bar. Nothing you view in that window will be accessible after you close it: no Web history, no saved cookies, no cached Internet files, no saved searches or URLs, no saved form data or passwords -- nothing.
