Can I increase/decrease the font size in Internet Explorer?

Answer:

While in Internet Explorer, Click **View**, select **Text Size**, and choose either Largest, Larger, Medium, Smaller, Smallest. If you do not see the View menu, right-click on the toolbar and click **Menu Bar**.

A temporary solution is to hold down the [Ctrl] key and scroll up and/or down with the wheel in-between the two buttons on your mouse. Be careful when printing though, this will also increase the print size. It will go back to normal when you close out.
