What is the difference between a Netbook and a Notebook?

Answer:

Netbooks typically have screens smaller than 10". Their processors are slower because they are intended for basic functions like internet browsing and email. They usually do not have a CD Rom drive and are not very upgradeable. Ports on Netbooks are limited. They are light weight which makes them great for portability. They are inexpensive.

Notebooks are larger, faster, have more option flexibility, have CD Roms, are more upgradeable and usually weigh more. They are built more for business and multi-media use.
