

What are the benefits of a wireless printer?

Answer:

Having a wireless network printer has a couple benefits. There is the obvious benefit of not needing a USB or Ethernet cable to connect to the printer, allowing you to place your printer where ever you would like it without concern of being close to a computer or router. Secondly, while it is possible to share a printer without a wireless connection, it allows considerable network flexibility. The host computer for the printer would not need to be turned on in order to use the printer, etc.

Setting up a wireless printer

Adding a printer to a wireless network is the same as adding any other device. You will need a printer that has a built in adapter or add an external wireless printer adapter which is compatible with your printer. You will also need a wireless print server/router. Typically the software that is included with your printer or printer adapter will walk you through the setup.

Some general computer knowledge and network passwords will be necessary.
