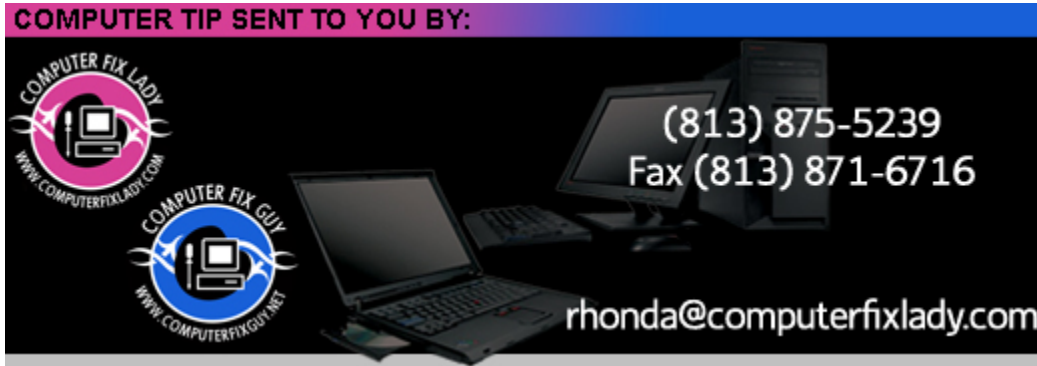

Can I view two windows side by side in Windows XP like I can in Windows 7?

Answer:

Smart Window or Snap, allows the user to view two windows side-by-side in Windows 7 without having to manually re-size either window. If you're running a different version of Windows such as Windows XP or Windows Vista there is a free program that will help you accomplish that goal.
