How can I place my favorite Web site on the Windows Start menu or desktop?

Answer:

To put on your Start Menu: Simply drag your favorite Web site address from your Internet Explorer Favorites onto the Windows Start button and let go before the Start menu opens. Or hold it over the Window Start button and drag it to All Programs after the Start menu opens, and then drag it wherever you want.

To put on your desktop: Drag your favorite website address from your internet explorer favorites onto the desktop. Or right click on the desktop and select New and then Shortcut. First type your favorite website address. On the next screen type the name you would like to call it. Your are finished!
