How do you clean your keyboard?

Answer:

Shut down your computer; disconnect the keyboard. Use your vacuum cleaner with its crevice tool to suck out any crud from your keys. If necessary, use tweezers to remove stubborn debris. Take a cloth and get it slightly wet with soapy water. Tilt your keyboard, so it is partly upside down, and so that none of your cleaning fluid will settle into the keyboard contacts; and then clean off your keyboard. It's that easy.
